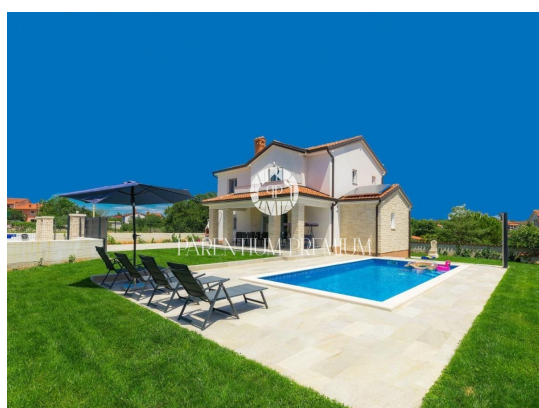
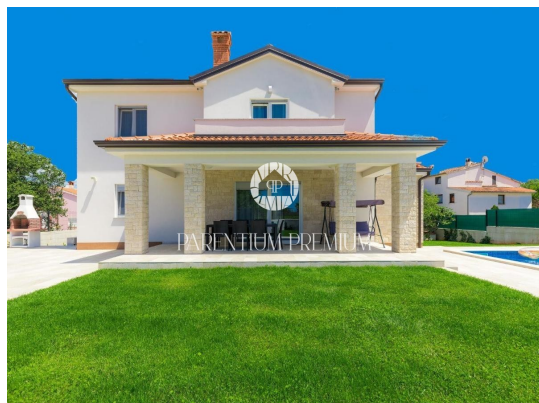

The house is equipped with air conditioners for heating/cooling and wall heating regulators if needed.
